



## **Call for EOI – Guide on Election Reporting (Re-advertised)**

As part of its UK Government funded ‘Building Public Confidence in Elections in Fiji through Civil Society Action’ project, Dialogue Fiji will be producing a Guide on Election Reporting for journalists covering the Fijian National Elections. The Guide will provide guidelines for journalists for fair and impartial coverage of elections in Fiji by detailing rules and standards for election time reporting, provide information on specifics of Fiji’s electoral system and processes, and provide practical guidelines for planning and executing coverage of campaigns and elections.

The guide should become a useful tool for journalists to understand key aspects of Fijian elections, including the media regulatory framework, the electoral legal framework, and key actors in the electoral and political process in Fiji. The aim is to assist the media/journalists in delivering a more robust and equitable coverage of future national elections.
